

**PENNSYLVANIA LIONS BEACON LODGE CAMP
JOB DESCRIPTION**

JOB TITLE: **OUTDOOR ADVENTURE SPECIALIST**

IMMEDIATE SUPERVISOR: Unit Director in consultation with Camp Coordinator.

QUALIFICATIONS: Should have coursework or demonstrable experience in camp-craft, scouting, spelunking, orienteering, hiking and/or wilderness survival.

DUTIES: (In addition to those of General Counselor)

1. Implementation and supervision of the following: wilderness survival, Mountain biking, orienteering, camp craft, river fishing, spelunking, special camp outs or other activities as outlined in the Outdoor Adventure Program Manual and utilizing personal experience and knowledge of additional activity ideas in consultation with the Camp Coordinator.
2. General care of all outdoor adventure program equipment. *(E.g.) clean out and sanitize canteens after use, clean marshmallow sticks and mountain pie makers. Take inventor of equipment when directed to do so.
3. Enforce all safety rules during instruction and outdoor trips.
4. Supervision of General Counselors assisting in program.
5. Develop and implement an award system for all participants to include certificates, patches or other in consultation with Camp Coordinator.
6. Evaluate need for replacement equipment and/or repairs of current equipment and submit a written needs list to Camp Coordinator.
7. During the Blind and Visual Sessions the following must be done: 1 overnight camping trip (A-frames), 1 hike to Licking Creek, 1 evening hike, 1 cave trip, and at least 3 on camp hikes.
8. Perform any other duty not mentioned here in order to operate a more successful summer camping program.
